

to Ponta dos Ganchos Resort




Anhatomirim Island. (A)




Bahia dos Golfinhos. (B)

Option 02 Scenic Route

Make the most of your trip to the resort by taking the slightly longer scenic route. Guests coming from the North on the BR 101 should take the exit at km 182. Those coming from the South should turn off at km 183. Follow the signs for Armação da Piedade and Palmas. The Resort is about 27 km from here.

The road will fork soon after passing through a small village, take the right. After passing two beaches, you will see a small signpost to the Baía dos Golfinhos (B). This is a great place to stop for photos. Keep going and you'll come to another junction in the road, take the left this time, and you'll go over a small bridge. Following the main road, you'll come to another junction (C). If you'd like to see a little more before you get to the Resort, take the right. A short stretch of unpaved road leads to the beach at Armaçãozinha, where you can see the oldest church in the state, Armação da Piedade (D), which has been maintained in the style in which it was built. After returning to the main road, and for those who didn't go to the church, take the left and follow it over the hill and you'll arrive in Palmas.

Drive through, and when you reach the headland at the other end, turn right up the hill. Just before the top, there is a place to stop that offers a view of the whole of the Palmas beach and beyond (E). Keep left on the way down the hill until you see signs for Ganchos de Fora and Ganchos do Meio, where you should take the right to Ganchos de Fora (G). After a short descent, take the first road on the left (look out for a red house). Follow this road to the end where you will find the entrance to the Resort (H). Welcome to Ponta dos Ganchos!
